Pre-Registration Recommended -- This is an **ABR** Event



The Race Details:

Registration: Team cost is \$100. Online registration is available at www.active.com. One person, the Team Captain, registers the whole team. The Team Captain must know the names, addresses, phone numbers and racing ages of each team member before logging into active.com. Online registration closes at midnight Thursday 9/8/2011. This is NOT a state championship event. Start times will be posted Friday evening 9/9/2011. Event will be held rain or shine. Same day registration will be available if event is not sold-out. This event insured by the **American Bicycle Racing Association**. *No USCF license required.* (<http://www.fiestaisland.com/fiestatt/ttt>)

Teams: Teams consist of four competitors. Mixed teams require two female riders. Three groups of teams are eligible; men's, women's, and mixed. Each group has three categories; Open (no age restrictions), 140+ cumulative age (no rider shall be over the age of 55 years of age), 180+ cumulative age (no rider shall be under the age of 30 years of age).

Race Day: Every rider is required to sign an **American Bicycle Racing** release form. It is suggested that one rider bring releases for entire team to registration. Download release form from ABR or race web sites ahead of time and impress you're the other teams. Four race numbers will be issued per team. Race numbers are available from 6:00 to 6:45 am. Registration closes at 6:45. If your team has not registered by 6:45, your numbers will be resold. The first team is off at 7:01 A.M. Teams will be released at 2-minute intervals. Time is established as the third team member crosses the finish line. It is not necessary for all four members to complete the TTT. All teams start with no assistance; one foot on the ground. Absolutely no feed or vehicle support allowed. Dropped team members must exit island immediately. It is not safe for individual riders to continue to circle the island. No warm up or cool down on racecourse. All racers are required to wear an ANSI certified bicycle helmet while racing.

Course: The course is a flat, fast, 40k closed to vehicles road course. Fiesta Island is the fastest island TT in North America. There is no more than 10 feet of climbing per lap. Each team will do 6 laps around the long course.

Prizes: Collectors edition Fiesta island time trial socks from **SockGuy** to 1st place finishers in each category and collector edition medals for top three places.

Results: Results will be posted on the web site as soon as possible following the race. The results are announced at the registration desk located at the entrance to the island.

Directions: From Interstate I-5, north or south, exit Sea World Drive, San Diego. Sea World Drive is approximately 5 miles north of downtown San Diego. Continue west on Sea World Drive to the first signal. Turn right on West Mission Bay Drive and take an immediate left to enter the island. Parking is on the right before you enter the island.
